A Top 5 finish at a Regional Finals allows you to advance to The American Rodeo Semi-Finals, May 22, 2026, at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas. The Top 5 from the American Rodeo Semi-Finals advance to The American Rodeo on May 23 for a shot at the \$2 Million Bonus!

IMPORTANT DEADLINES: All qualified (Automatic Advancements & points qualifiers) athletes must confirm their intent to compete at the American Rodeo West Regionals between March 30 - April 1, 2026, no later than 5 PM CST via text @719.338.5263, or email competition@tetonridge.com. All Turnouts must be submitted via email to competition@tetonridge.com no later than APRIL 29 at 5 PM PT.

April 15 by 5 PM CST is the deadline for stall reservations. If you want stalls guaranteed and/or next to your traveling partners, advance reservations are required. Tack stalls are recommended. A Haul-in Fee of \$30 per horse will be charged for anyone not stalling at the South Point. Anyone overnighting on the grounds must purchase a stall for their horse(s). Overnight tie-outs are not allowed by South Point. No arrivals prior to 8AM on Wednesday, April 29. For stall questions, contact Ross Wright (405-230-7167 x 501).

Stall assignments will be posted by April 24. Any stall refunds must be requested by Monday, APRIL 27 @ 5PM Central Time.

All stalls include a pre-bed of 4 bags of shavings, including tack stalls. Additional shavings are \$12.50/bag. Additional bedding may be purchased from the South Point Arena Feed Store located in the stall area.

To eliminate congestion in the South Point barns there is a 15-minute time limit to unload and vacate the alley. Golf carts and staff will be available to help you move your tack and feed to your stalls.

STALL MATS: Mats are \$40 per stall. This provides 2 mats that cover the stall. If you wish to pre-order mats to expedite move-in, please order through the South Point Arena Feed Store.

TRACTOR SUPPLY HOURS: Wed. 8AM-8PM; Thurs.–Sat. 8AM-6PM. It is recommended to use the pre-order link above for feed/bedding if arriving outside these hours.

PARKING: Once you've unloaded, South Point security will direct you to trailer parking areas.

CHECK-IN: Check-in is Wednesday, April 29, from 9AM to 6PM, and Thursday starting at 6 AM until two hours prior to your event. Check-in is at the South Point Arena show office. Check-in remains open each day. All athletes must be checked in at least two hours prior to their competition or ride-time participation.

PAYOUT: All earnings will be paid via ACH Direct Deposit 7 business days from the conclusion of the event. Payments will not be processed without a signed W9, W8 (non U.S. resident) and athlete agreement on file. No EINs will be accepted. **You must fill in all financial information via the link below prior to the event in order to get paid:**

OFFICE HOURS: See schedule for office hours. The office remains open until the end of each daily competition.

FINALISTS: There is a mandatory contestant meeting for all Finalists on Saturday at 11 AM in the outside the show office. All Saturday Finalists will need to take a headshot dressed in Western attire on Saturday morning between 9 AM and 11 AM at the photo station on the arena concourse outside the Saloon. You will receive a new Finals back number at this time as well as a minimum of two companion tickets and one helper pass.

HEALTH DOCUMENTS: A negative Coggins dated within 12 months of the event and a 30-day health certificate is required and will be checked upon arrival. ALL horses, including non-compete horses, must have health documents to enter the facility. In the event any additional paperwork is required we will communicate updates as needed.

STREAMING: The American Regional Semi-Finals will stream live on the Cowboy Channel Plus app.

TELEVISED FINALS: The American Regional Finals will be televised LIVE on FS1!

AMERICAN REGIONAL SEMI-FINAL FORMATS FOR TIMED EVENTS:

- ★ Each American Rodeo Regional Semi-Finals consists of two long go-rounds.
- ★ Based on the aggregate of Go Rounds 1 and 2, the Top 10 fastest Qualifiers advance to the Finals.
- ★ Athletes who do not earn a spot in the Top 10 aggregate may enter the Redemption Round.
- ★ The Top 3 from the Redemption Round advance to the Finals for a total of 13, plus Super Qualifiers.
- ★ Athletes who make the Top 10 will make three (3) runs total over the course of the three (3) days.
- ★ Athletes who qualify for the Finals via the Redemption Round may make four (4) runs total over three (3) days

AMERICAN REGIONAL SEMI-FINAL FORMATS ROUGHSTOCK:

- ★ Roughstock athletes will compete in one preliminary go-round. Athletes eligible to compete in the Regional Finals are the top 10 athletes from the Semi-finals, plus eligible American Rodeo Super Qualifiers.
